WHO:

The Central Coast Joint Data Committee and AMBAG, in cooperation with Santa Cruz County, the Federal Geographic Data Committee (FGDC), and the California Resources Agency CERES Program.

WHAT:

Hands-on training in FGDC-compliant metadata development, using California's on-line metadata program developed through the CERES Program..

Attendees will be briefed on the FGDC metadata standard for digital geospatial data and various approaches to metadata development. The bulk of the two hour training period will be spent with each individual developing actual FGDC-compliant metadata and metadata catalogs using CERES. The training will include substantial coverage of CERES tools to import and export XML metadata from GIS software.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND:

All individuals creating, maintaining or using data; particularly spatial data often used in GIS, although any data can be addressed.
